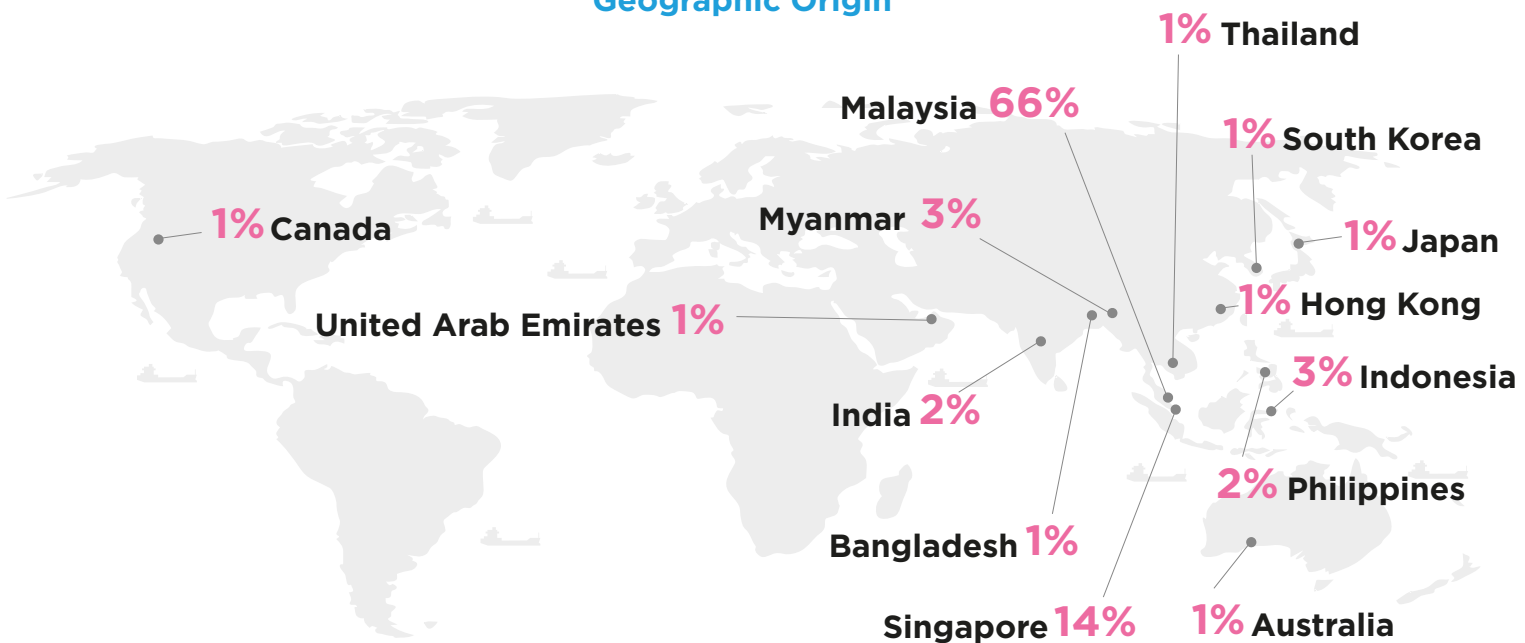

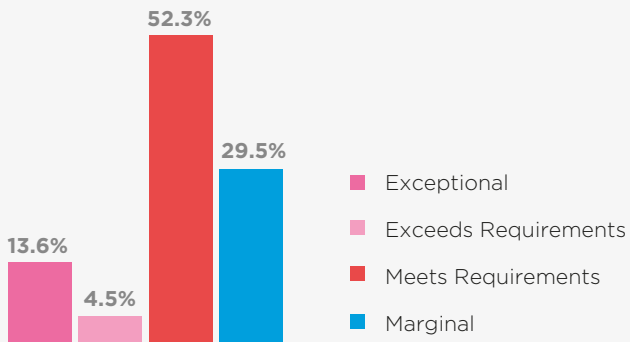

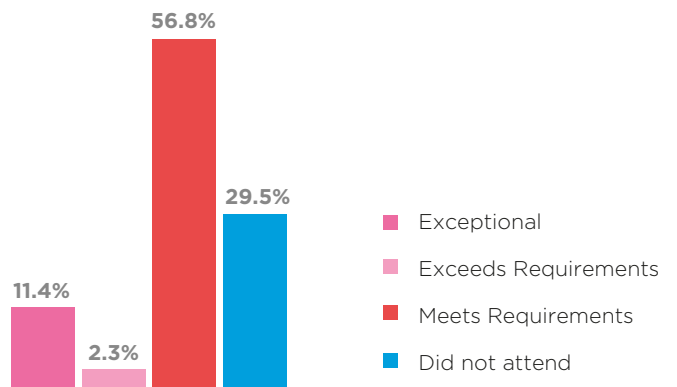

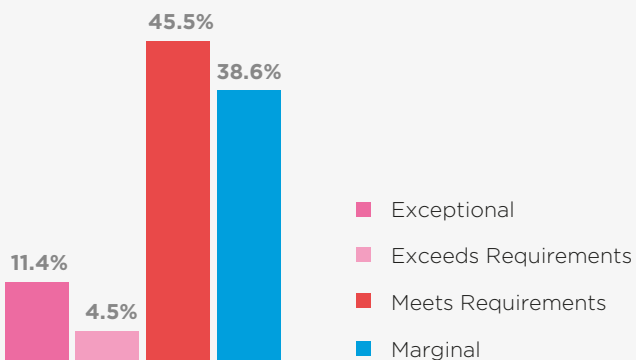

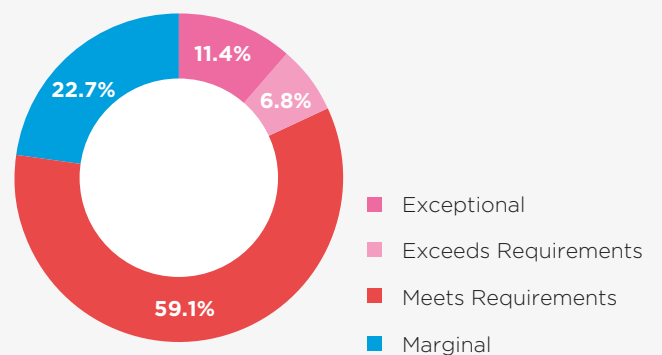
Overall, How would you Rate the Session I De-escalating therapy in Early Breast Cancer

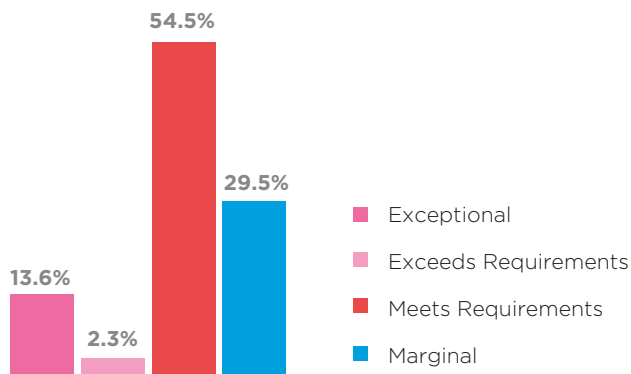

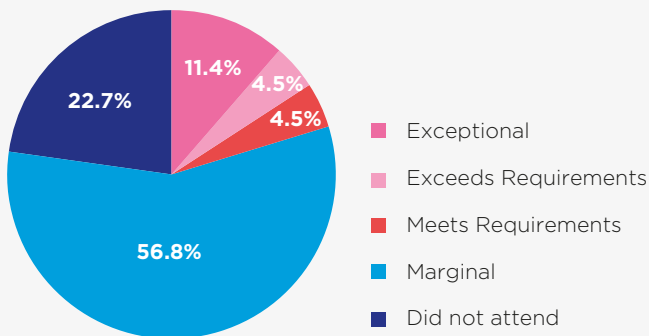

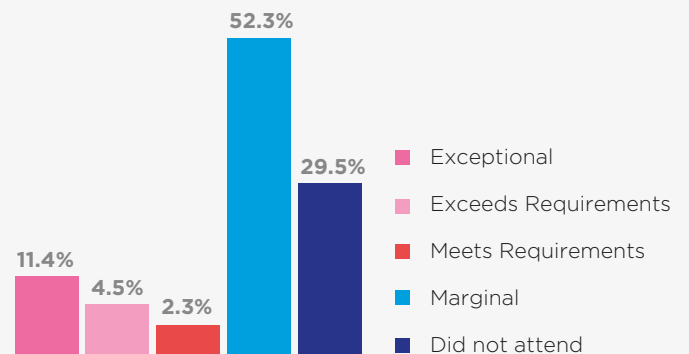

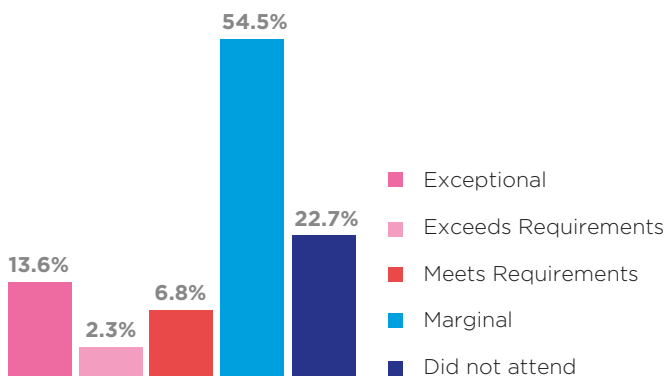

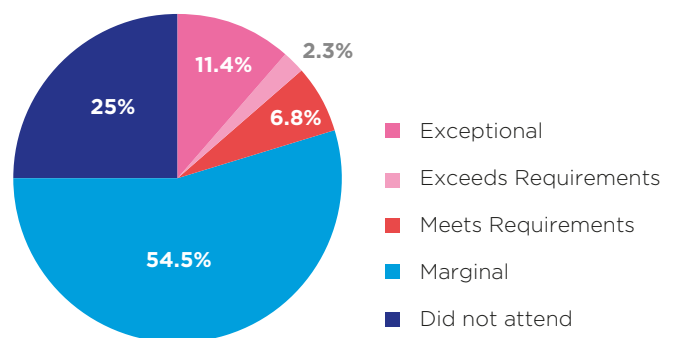

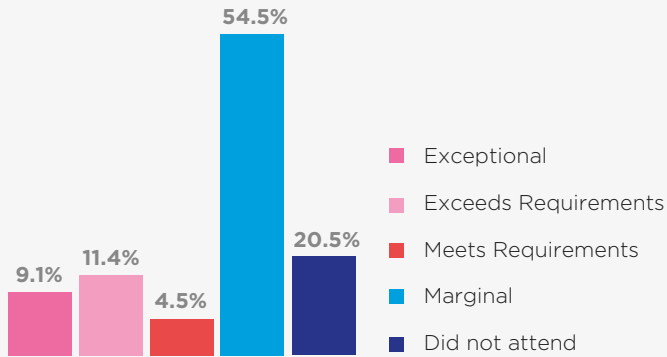

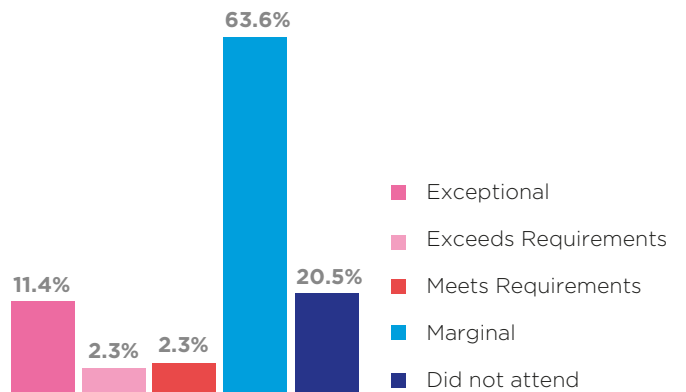

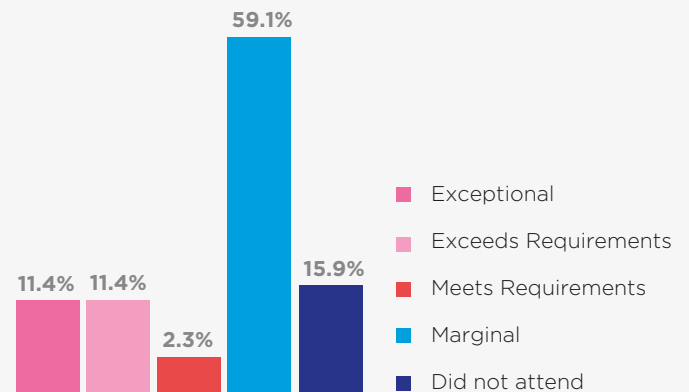
